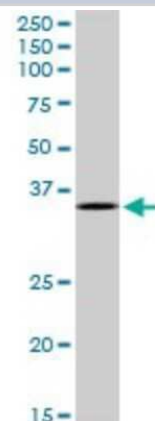

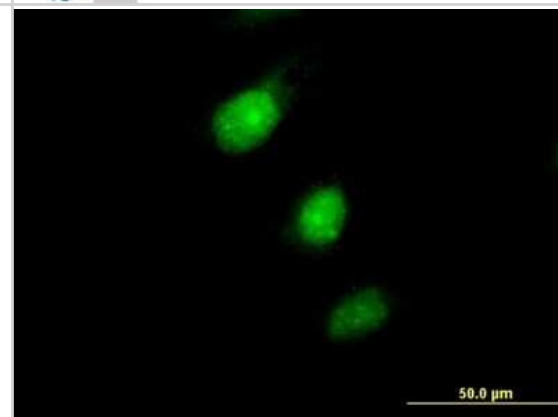

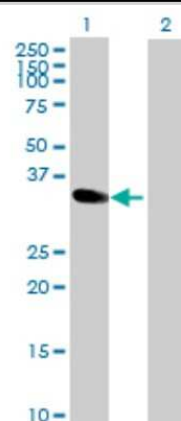
Western Blot: MAD2L1-binding protein Antibody [H00009587-B01P] - Analysis of MAD2L1BP expression in A-431.
