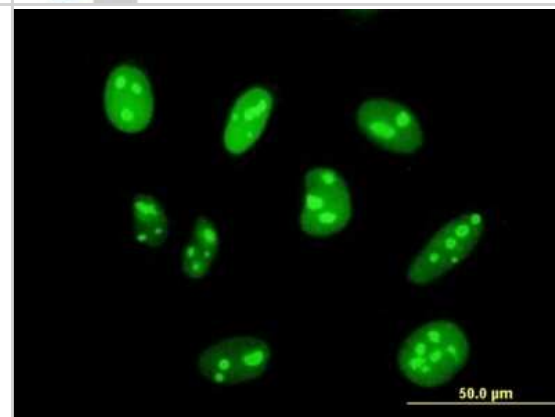

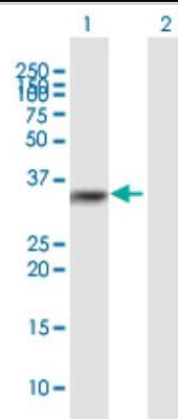
Western Blot: DIMIT1L Antibody [H00027292-B01P] - Analysis of HSA9761 expression in rat brain.
