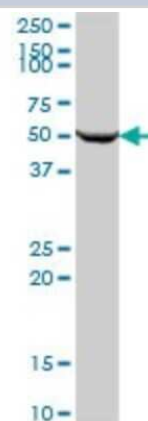

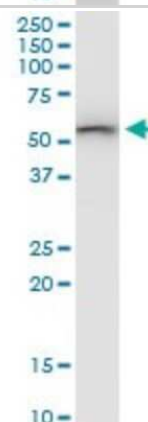

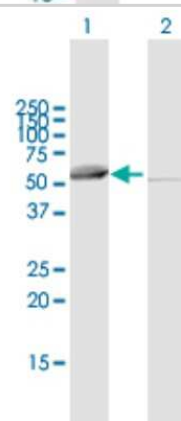
Western Blot: SARS2 Antibody [H00054938-B01P] - Analysis of SARS2 expression in human liver.
