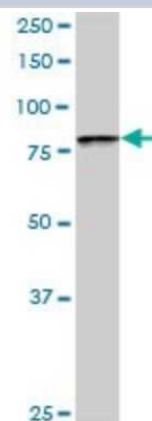

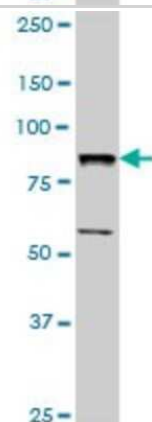

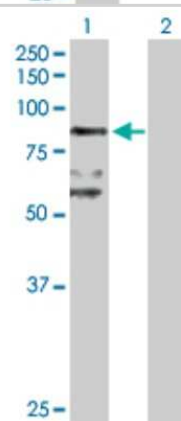
Western Blot: BBS7 Antibody [H00055212-D01P] - Analysis of BBS7 expression in mouse lung.
