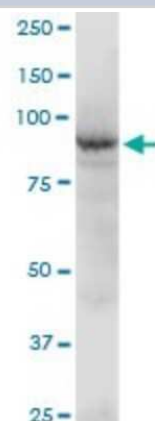

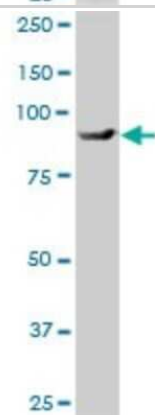

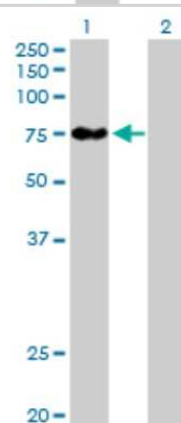
Western Blot: BBS12 Antibody [H00166379-B01P] - Analysis of BBS12 expression in NIH/3T3.
