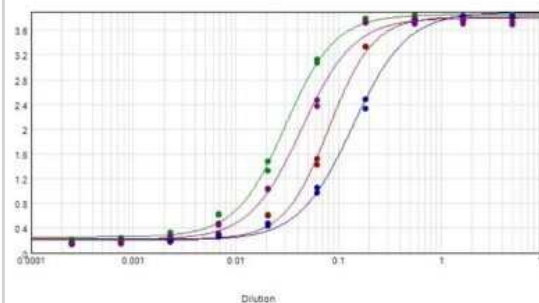

Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Human IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-biotin, anti-Goat Serum, Human IgG, and Human Serum.

Application Notes	This product has been tested by ELISA and is assayed against 1.0 ug of Human IgG in a standard capture ELISA using Peroxidase Conjugated Streptavidin and ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:100,000 to 1:400,000 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.

ELISA: Goat anti-Human IgG (H+L) Secondary Antibody [Biotin] [NB120-6857] - ELISA results of purified Goat anti-Human IgG (H+L) Secondary Antibody [Biotin] tested against purified human IgG. Each well was coated in duplicate with 1.0 ug of human IgG (purple line). The starting dilution of antibody was 5ug/ml and the X-axis represents the Log10 of a 3-fold dilution. This titration is a 4-parameter curve fit where the IC50 is defined as the titer of the antibody. Assay performed using blocking buffer, Streptavidin HRP conjugate 1:10000, and TMB substrate.
