Freezing alkaline phosphatase conjugates will result in a substantial loss of enzymatic activity.</p>



Application Notes	This secondary antibody has been assayed against 1.0 ug of Rat IgG in a standard capture ELISA using pNPP p-nitrophenyl phosphate as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:2,500 to 1:10,800 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.

Lane 4: Rat IgM Whole Molecule. All samples were reduced. Load: 50 ng per lane. Block: incubated with blocking buffer for 30 min at RT. Primary Antibody: Anti-Rat IgG F(ab')2 (RABBIT) Antibody 1:1,000 for 60 min at RT. Secondary Antibody: Anti-Rabbit IgG (GOAT) Peroxidase Conjugated Antibody 1:40,000 in incubated with blocking buffer for 30 min at RT.

Predicted/Observed Size: 25 and 55 kDa for Rat IgG, 25 kDa for F(c) and Fab, 78 and 25 kDa for IgM. Rat F(c) migrates slightly higher.
