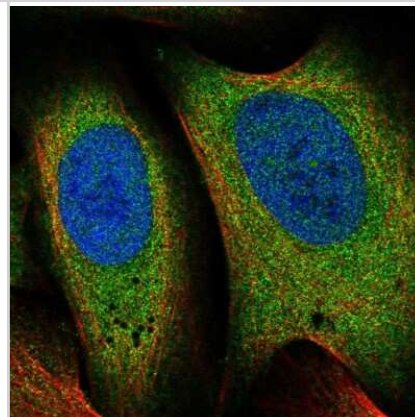

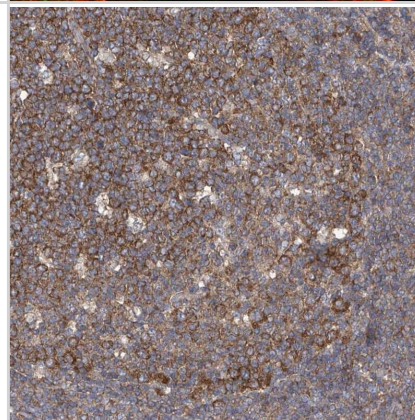

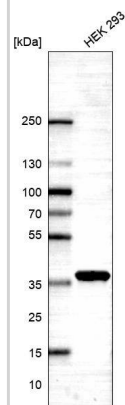

Staining of human tonsil shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in germinal center cells and non-germinal center cells.

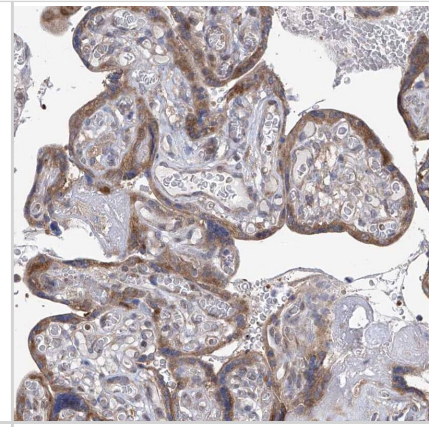


Analysis in human cell line HEK 293.

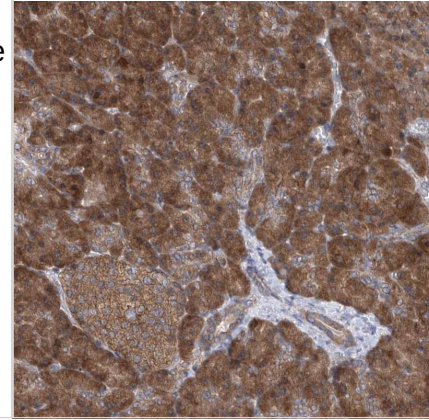


Staining of human testis shows moderate cytoplasmic positivity in cells in seminiferous ducts and leydig cells.
