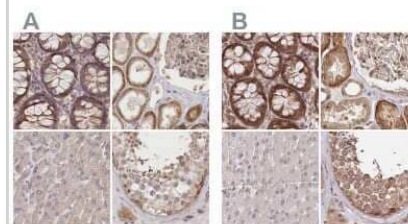

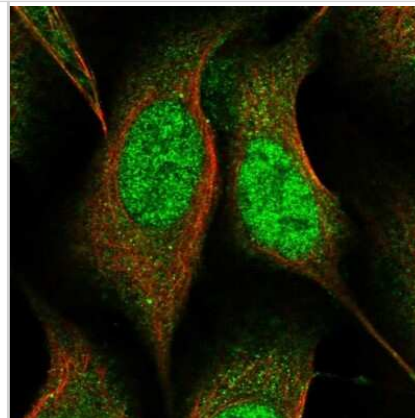

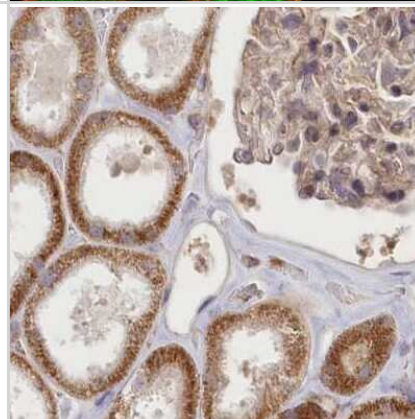

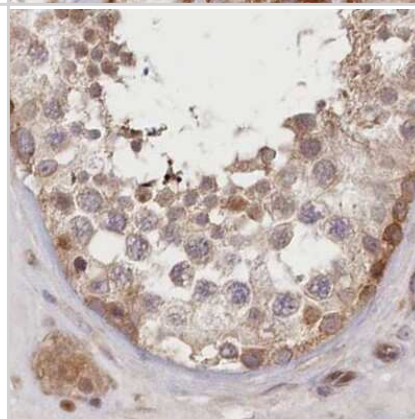

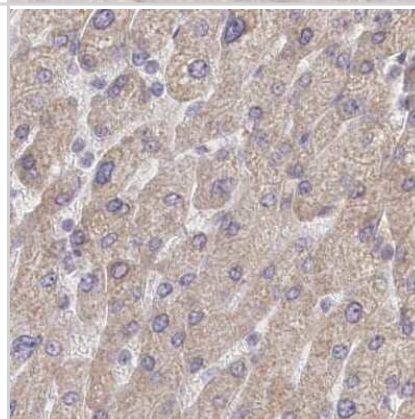
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: CEP70 Antibody [NBP1-88594] - Staining of human kidney.



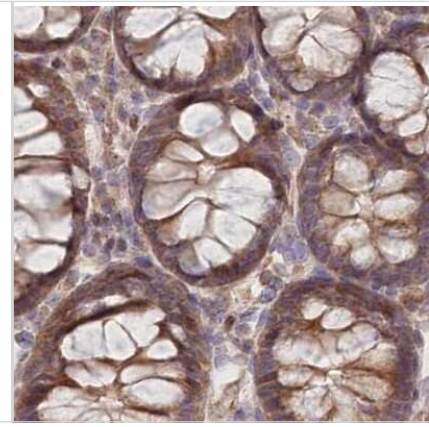
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: CEP70 Antibody [NBP1-88594] - Staining of human testis.
