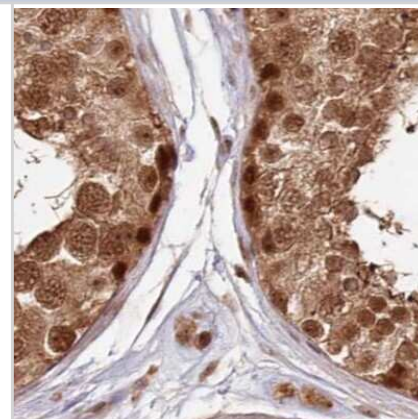

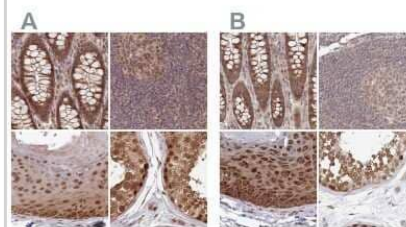

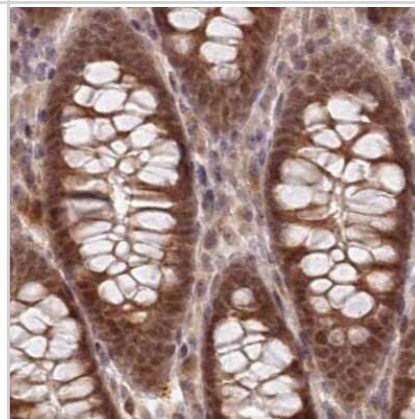
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: WAPL Antibody [NBP1-92579] - Staining of human testis.



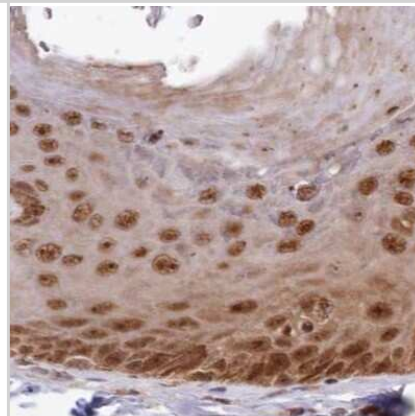

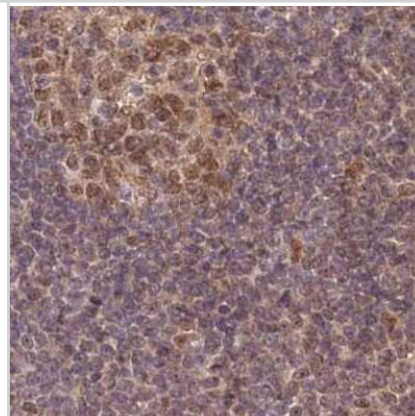
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: WAPL Antibody [NBP1-92579] - Staining of human colon.



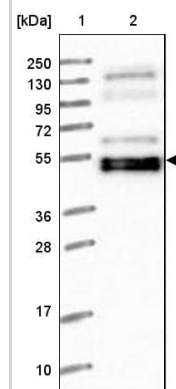
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: WAPL Antibody [NBP1-92579] - Staining of human skin.
