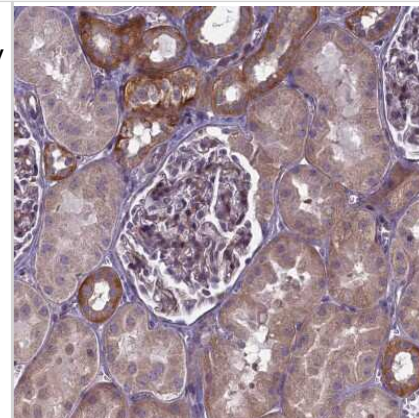

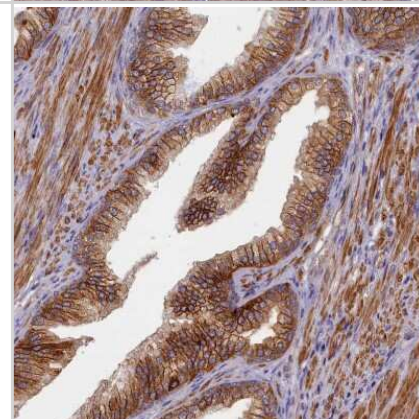

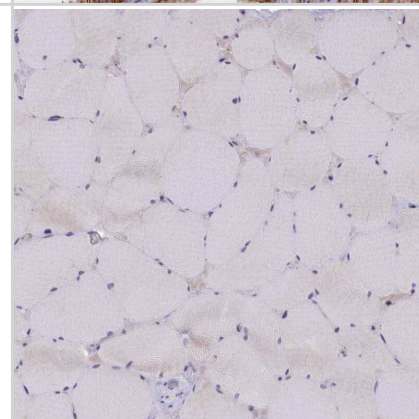

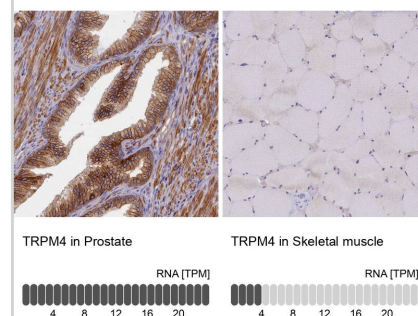
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: TRPM4 Antibody [NBP2-13487] - Staining of human prostate shows strong membranous positivity in glandular cells and smooth muscle cells.



Staining of human skeletal muscle shows no positivity in myocytes as expected.
