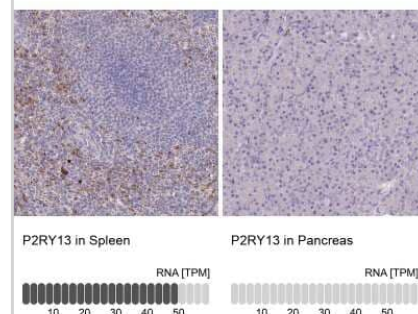

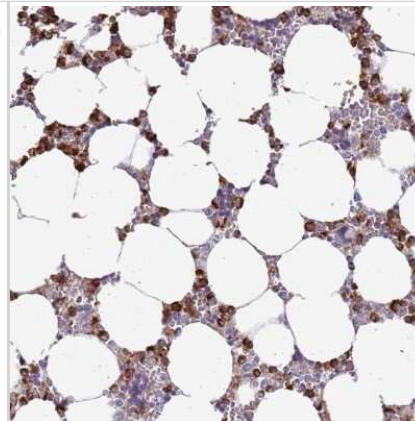

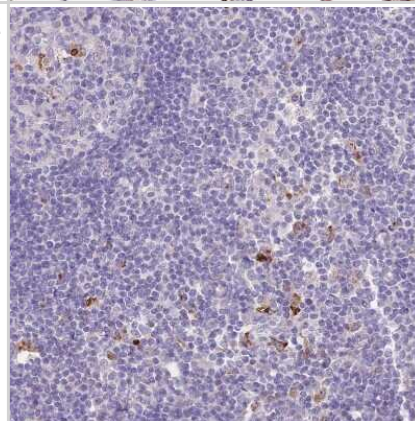

Corresponding P2RY13 RNA-seq data are presented for the same tissues.



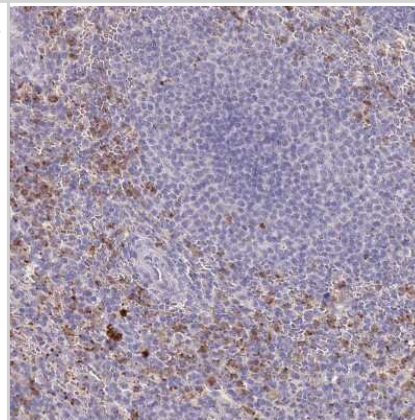

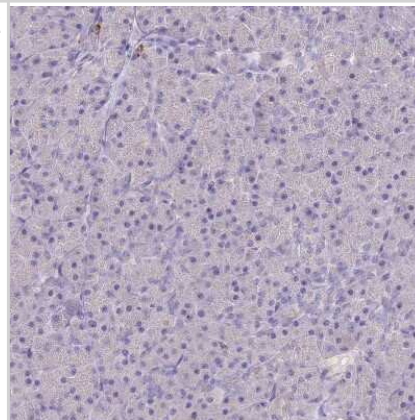
