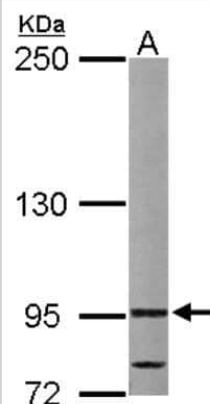

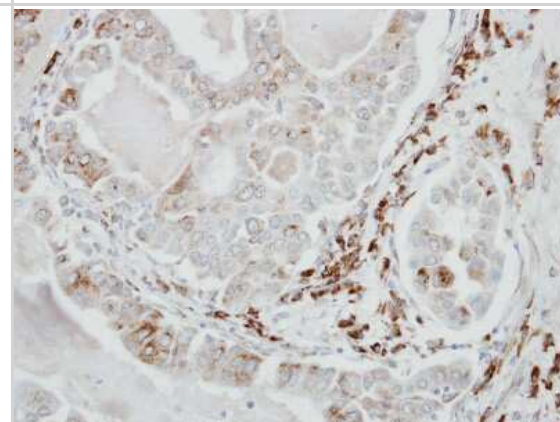

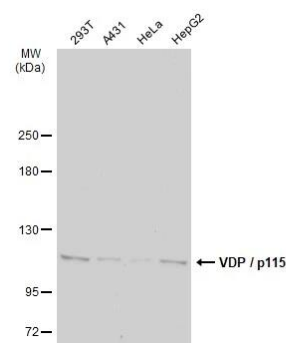

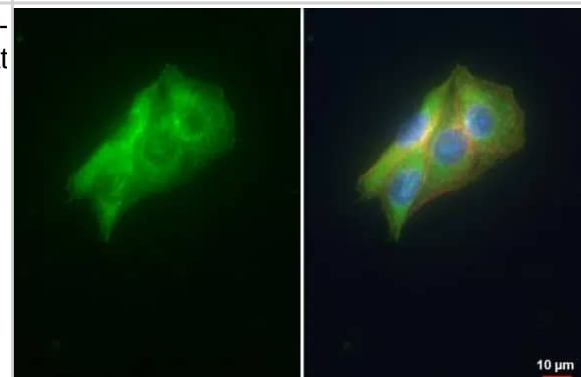
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: VDP p115 Antibody [NBP2-17245] - Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded lung AdCA, using antibody at 1:500 dilution.



Western Blot: VDP p115 Antibody [NBP2-17245] - Various whole cell extracts (30 ug) were separated by 5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with VDP p115 antibody [N1N2], N-term (NBP2-17245) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody.



Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence: VDP p115 Antibody [NBP2-17245] - VDP p115 antibody [N1N2], N-term detects VDP p115 protein at cytoplasm and golgi apparatus by immunofluorescent analysis. Sample: HepG2 cells were fixed in ice-cold MeOH for 5 min. Green: VDP p115 stained by VDP p115 antibody [N1N2], N-term (NBP2-17245) diluted at 1:500. Red: alpha Tubulin, a cytoskeleton marker, stained by alpha Tubulin antibody [GT114] diluted at 1:1000. Blue: Fluoroshield with DAPI.
