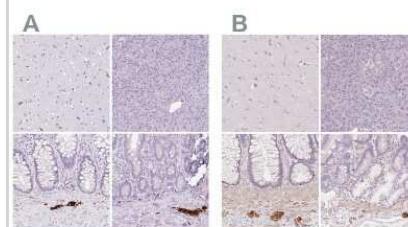

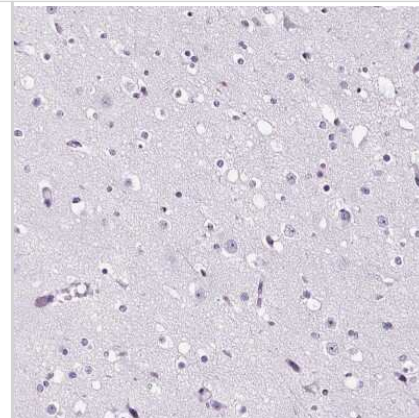

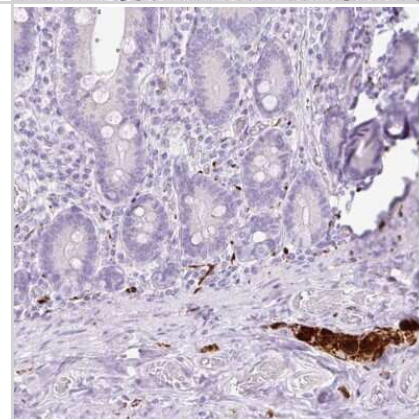

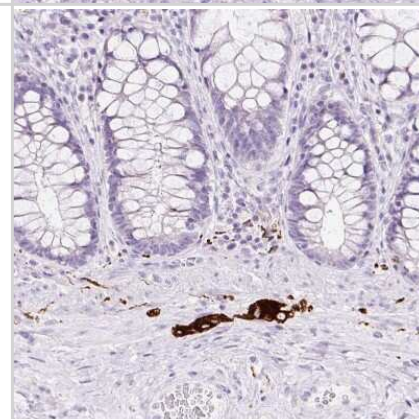

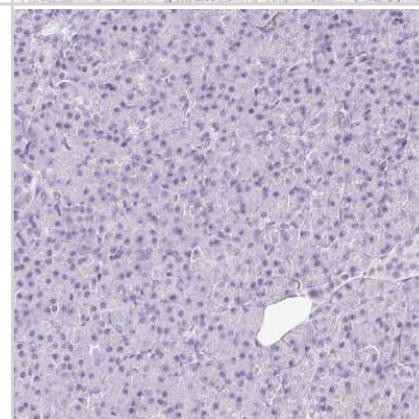

Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Peripherin Antibody [NBP2-38444] - Staining of human pancreas shows no positivity in exocrine glandular cells as expected.
