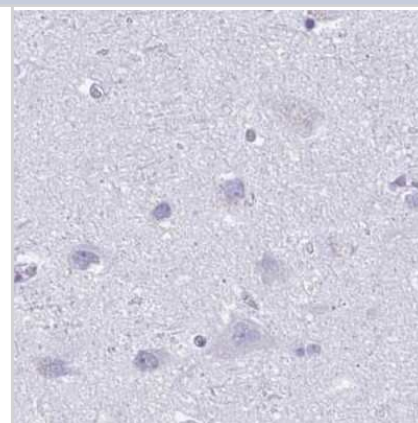

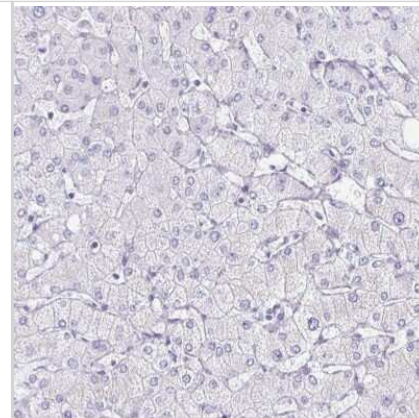

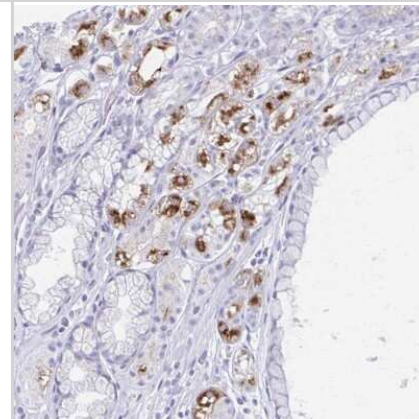
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: MiRP1 Antibody [NBP2-38653] - Staining of human cerebral cortex.



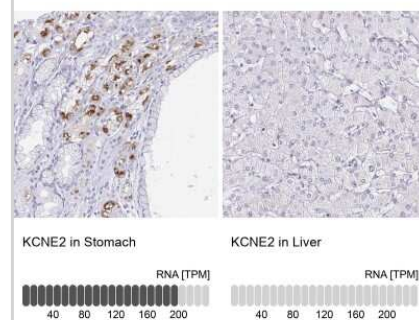
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: MiRP1 Antibody [NBP2-38653] - Staining of human liver shows low expression as expected.



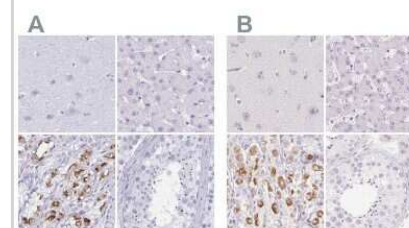
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: MiRP1 Antibody [NBP2-38653] - Staining of human stomach shows high expression.



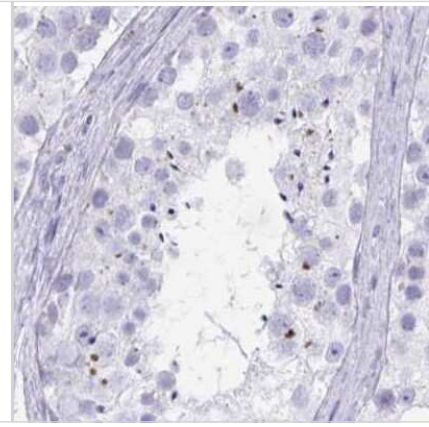
