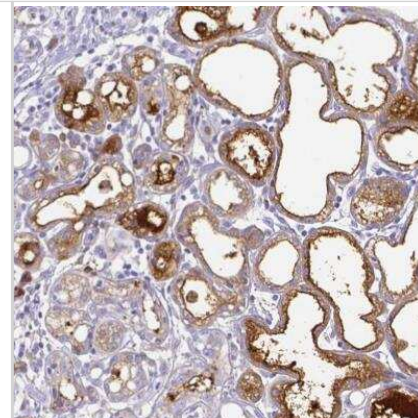

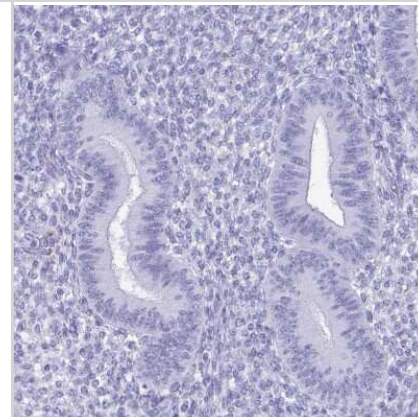

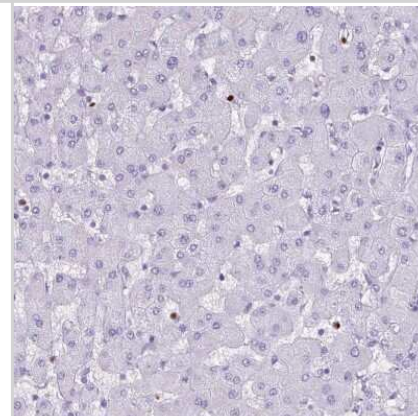
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Lactoferrin Antibody [NBP2-38885] - Staining of human lactating breast shows strong positivity.



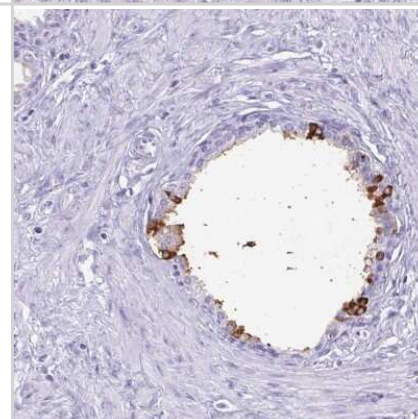

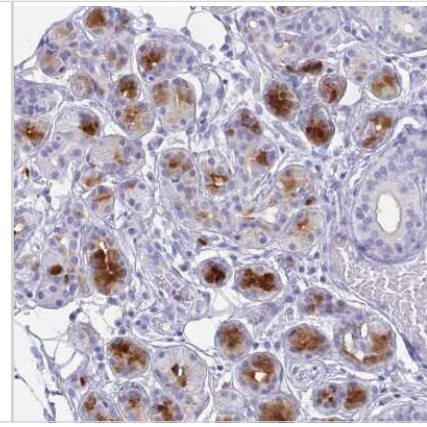
