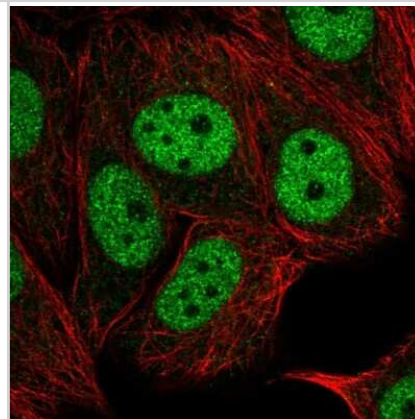

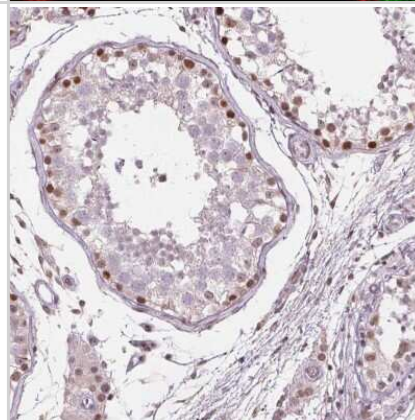

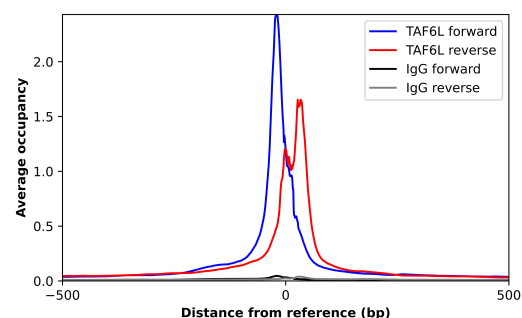

Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: TAF6L Antibody [NBP2-39083] - Staining of human testis shows moderate nuclear positivity in subset of cells in seminiferous ducts.



ChIP-Exo-Seq composite graph for Anti-TAF6L (NBP2-39083) tested in K562 cells. Strand-specific reads (blue: forward, red: reverse) and IgG controls (black: forward, grey: reverse) are plotted against the distance from a composite set of reference binding sites. The antibody exhibits robust target enrichment compared to a non-specific IgG control and precisely reveals its structural organization around the binding site. Data generated by Prof. B. F.
