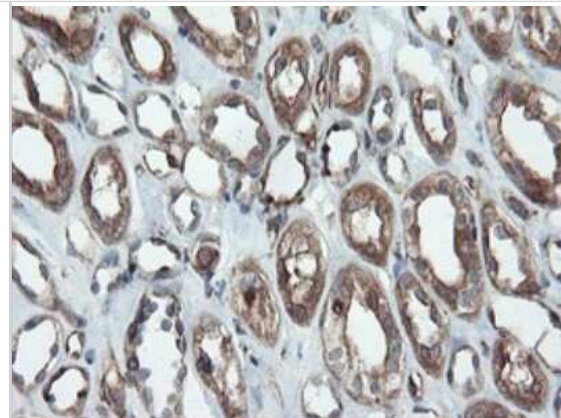

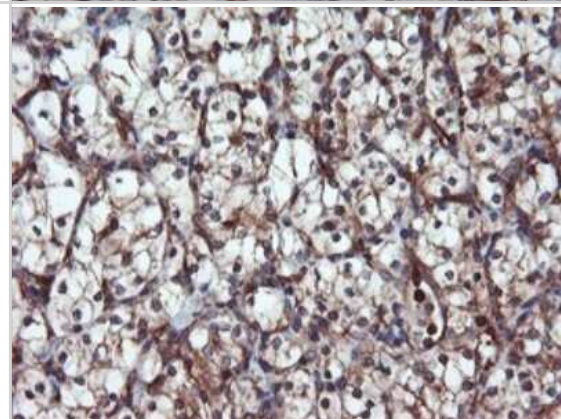

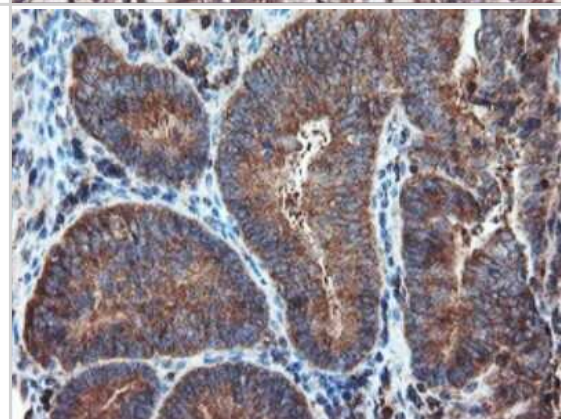
Immunohistochemistry: Proteasome 20S alpha 6 Antibody (3B8) [NBP2-45419] - Analysis of Human Kidney tissue.



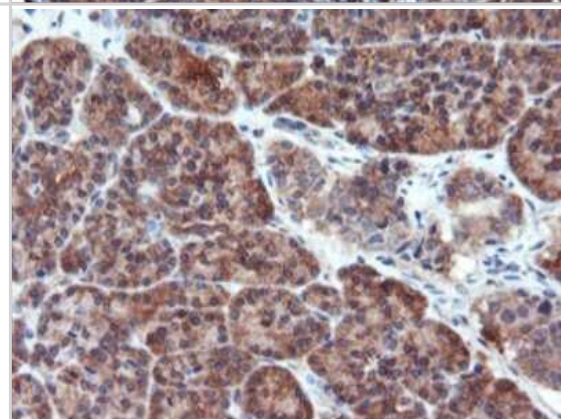

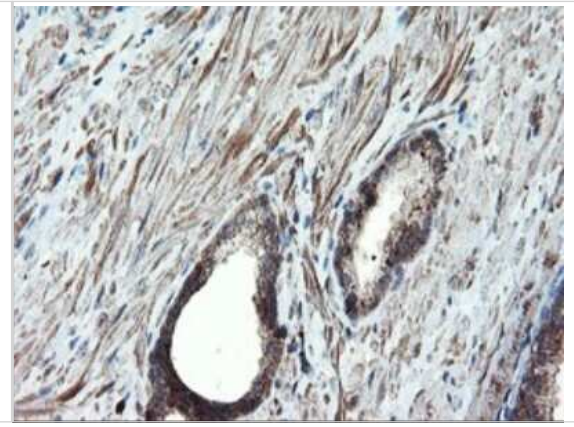
