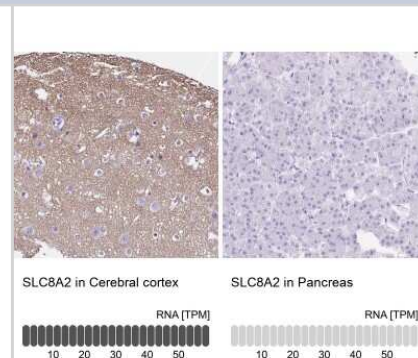

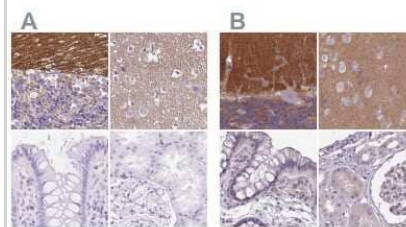

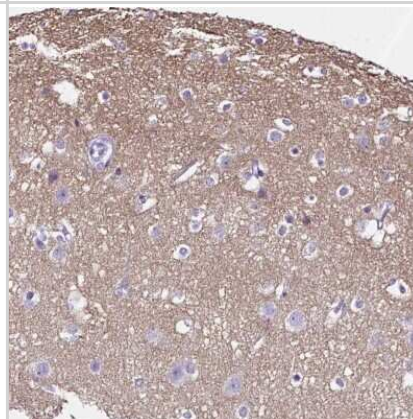

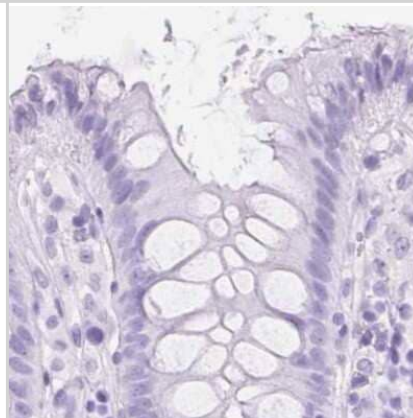

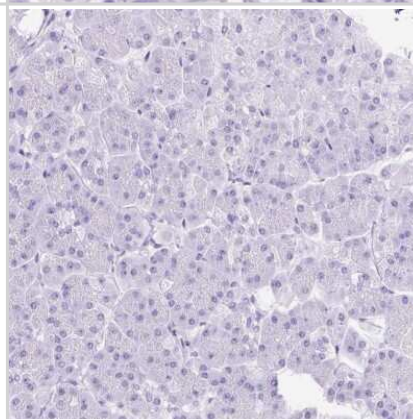
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: SLC8A2 Antibody [NBP2-49145] - Staining of human cerebral cortex shows high expression.



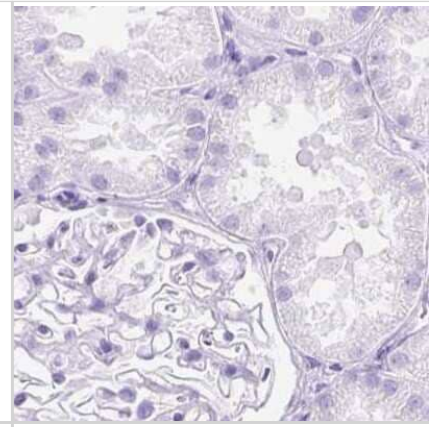
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: SLC8A2 Antibody [NBP2-49145] - Staining of human colon.



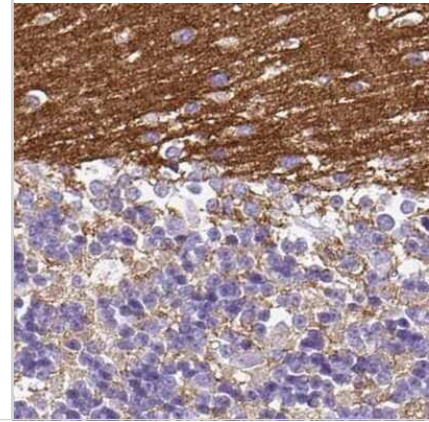
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: SLC8A2 Antibody [NBP2-49145] - Staining of human pancreas shows low expression as expected.
