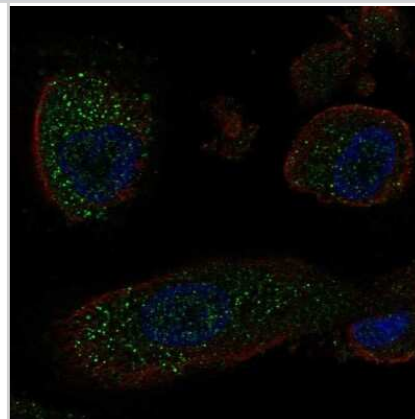

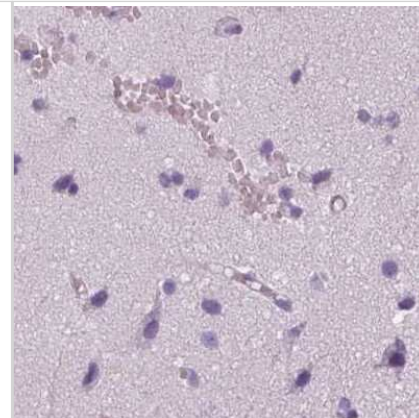

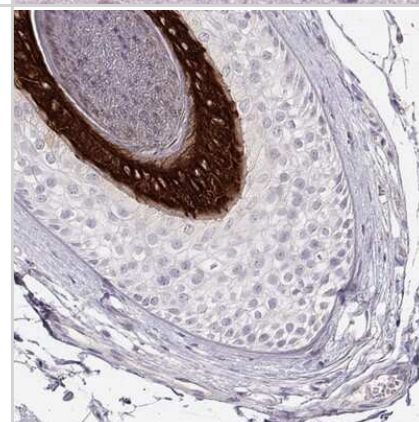

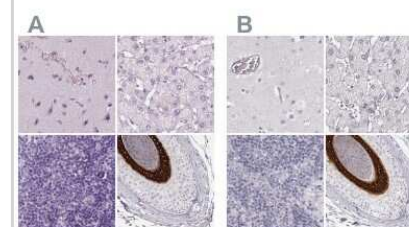
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: KRT25 Antibody [NBP2-58547] - Staining of human cerebral cortex.



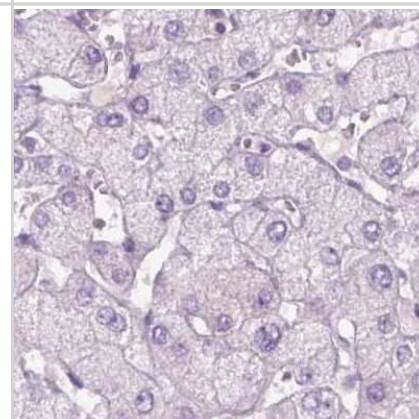

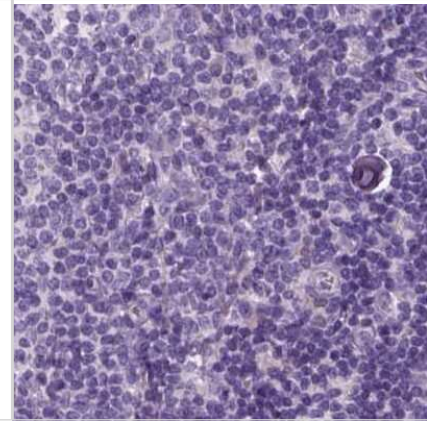
