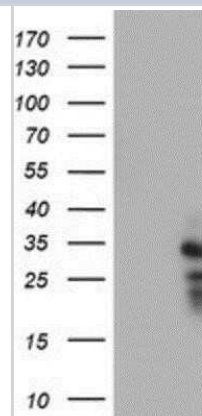

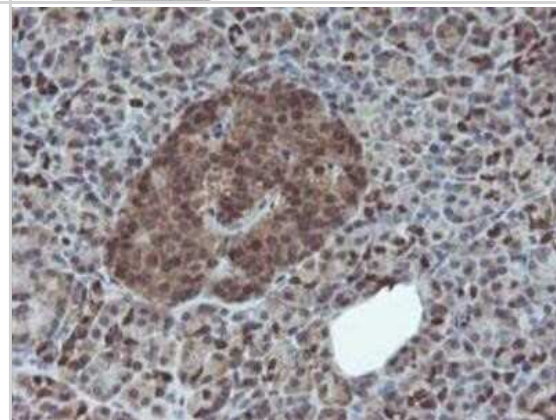

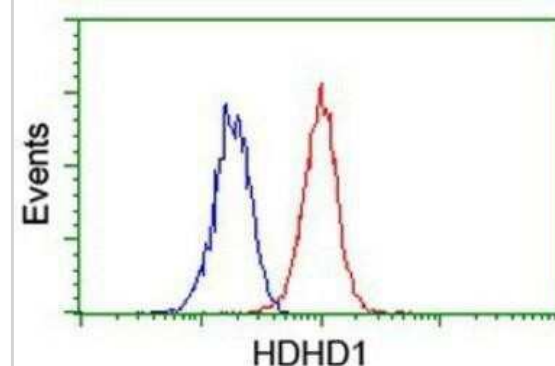
Western Blot: HDHD1A Antibody (OTI7A2) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP2-71368] - HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY HDHD1A (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-HDHD1A.



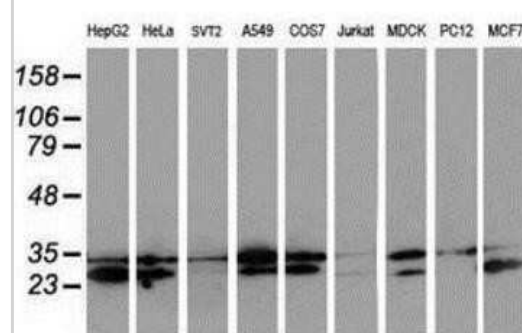

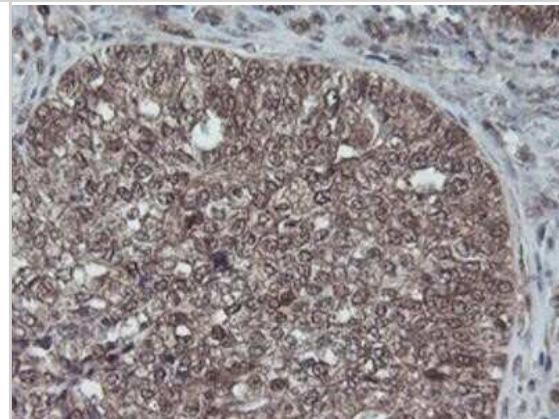

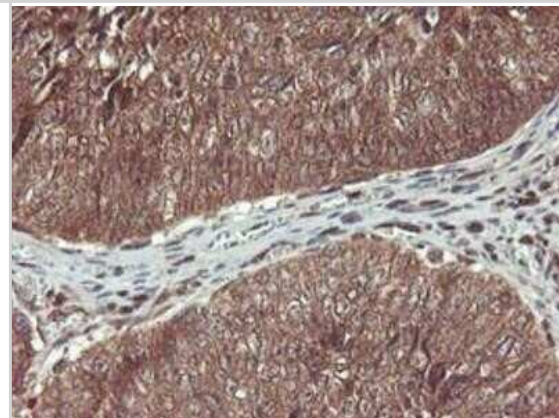

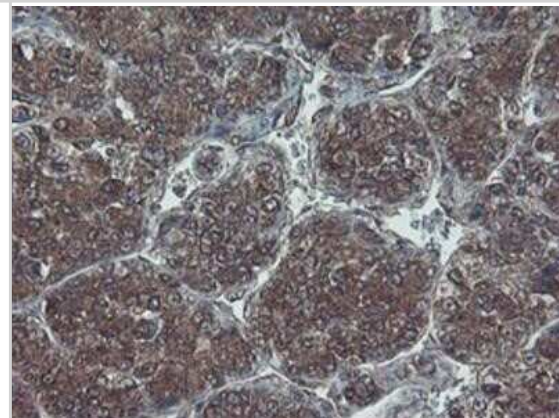

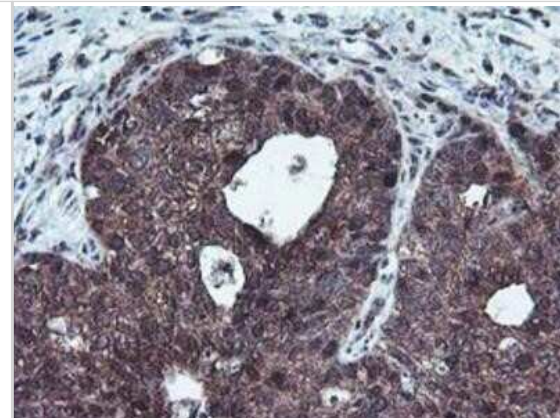

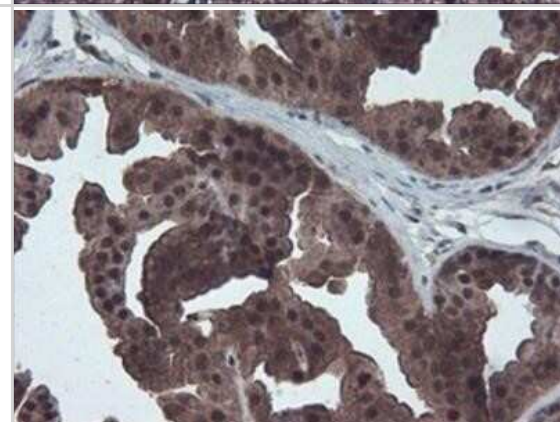

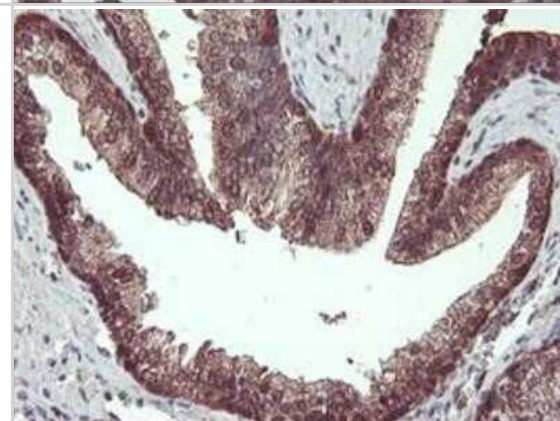

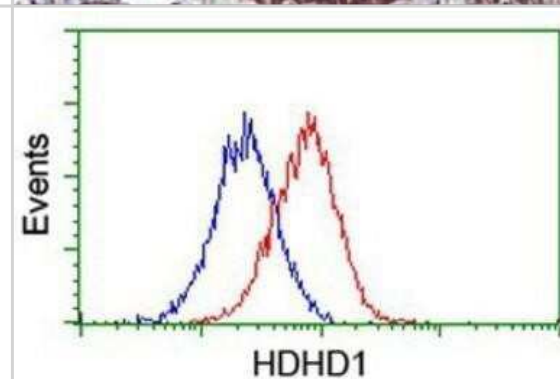
