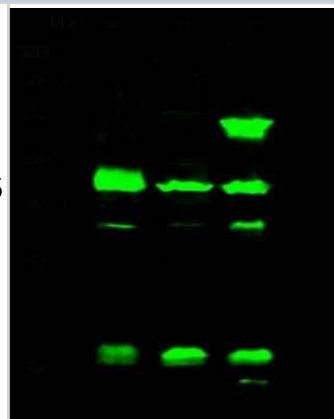

Lane C: A431 Whole Cell Lysate. Lysates/proteins at 30 ug per lane. Secondary Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (Dylight 800) at 1/10000 dilution. Developed using the Odyssey technique. Performed under reducing conditions. Predicted band size: 15 kDa. Observed band size: 16 kDa (We are unsure as to the identity of these extra bands).



Immunoprecipitation: Histone H3.3A Antibody [NBP2-98769] - Histone H3.3A was immunoprecipitated using: Lane A: 0.5 mg Jurkat Whole Cell Lysate. Lane B: 0.5 mg K562 Whole Cell Lysate 2 ul anti-Histone H3.3A rabbit polyclonal antibody and 15 ul of 50 % Protein G agarose. Primary antibody: Anti-Histone H3.3A rabbit polyclonal antibody, at 1:100 dilution. Secondary antibody: Dylight 800-labeled antibody to rabbit IgG (H+L), at 1:5000 dilution. Developed using the Odyssey technique. Performed under reducing conditions. Predicted band size: 15 kDa. Observed band size: 15 kDa
