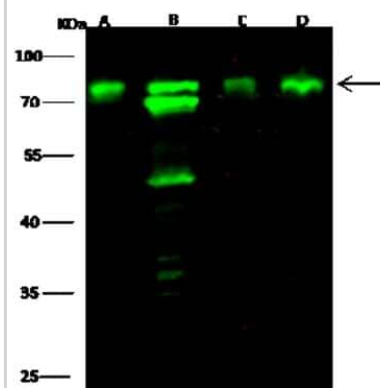

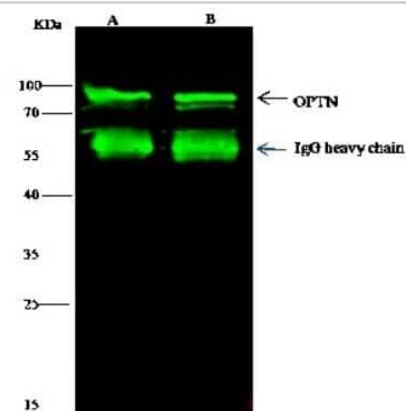

Western Blot: Optineurin Antibody [NBP3-00298] - Anti-Optineurin rabbit polyclonal antibody at 1:500 dilution. Lane A: HepG2 Whole Cell Lysate. Lane B: A431 Whole Cell Lysate. Lane C: Hela Whole Cell Lysate. Lane D: NCI-H1299 Whole Cell Lysate. Lysates/proteins at 30 ug per lane. Secondary Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (Dylight 800) at 1/10000 dilution. Developed using the Odyssey technique. Performed under reducing conditions. Predicted band size: 66 kDa. Observed band size: 75 kDa (We are unsure as to the identity of these extra bands).



Immunoprecipitation: Optineurin Antibody [NBP3-00298] - Optineurin was immunoprecipitated using: Lane A: 0.5 mg Hela Whole Cell Lysate. Lane B: 0.5 mg HepG2 Whole Cell Lysate. 2 ul anti-Optineurin rabbit polyclonal antibody and 60 ug of Immunomagnetic beads. Protein G. Primary antibody: Anti-Optineurin rabbit polyclonal antibody, at 1:100 dilution. Secondary antibody: Dylight 800-labeled antibody to rabbit IgG (H+L), at 1:5000 dilution. Developed using the Odyssey technique. Performed under reducing conditions. Predicted band size: 66 kDa. Observed band size: 75 kDa
