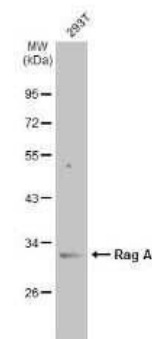

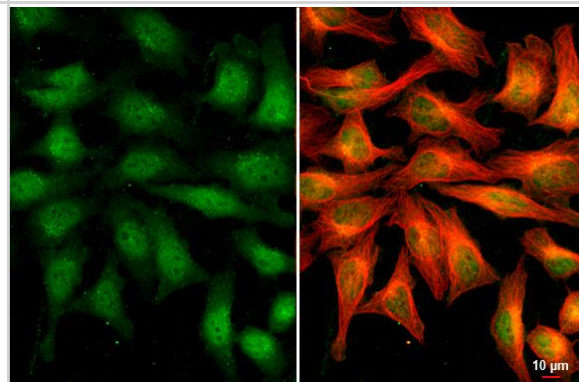

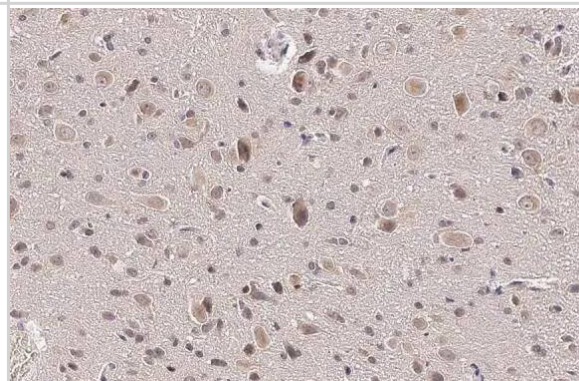
Western Blot: RRAGA Antibody [NBP3-13446] - Whole cell extract (30 ug) was separated by 10% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with RRAGA antibody (NBP3-13446) diluted at 1:5000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (NBP2-19301) was used to detect the primary antibody.



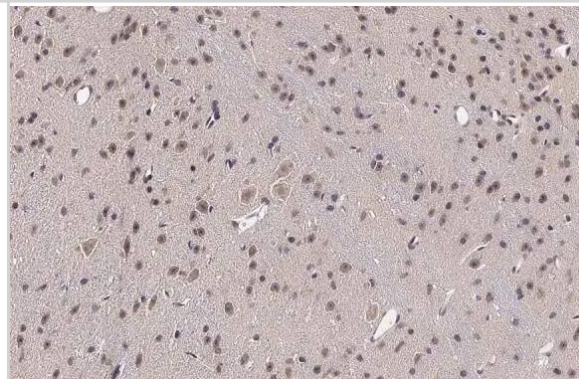
Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence: RRAGA Antibody [NBP3-13446] - RRAGA antibody detects RRAGA protein at cytoplasm and nucleus by immunofluorescent analysis. Sample: HeLa cells were fixed in 4% paraformaldehyde at RT for 15 min. Green: RRAGA stained by RRAGA antibody (NBP3-13446) diluted at 1:500. Red: alpha Tubulin, a cytoskeleton marker, stained by alpha Tubulin antibody [GT114] diluted at 1:1000. Scale bar= 10um.
