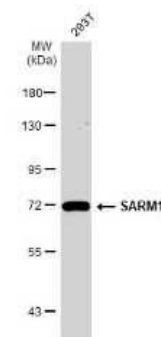

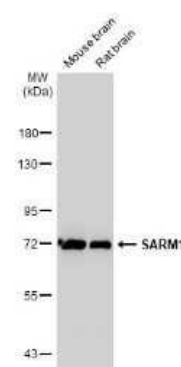

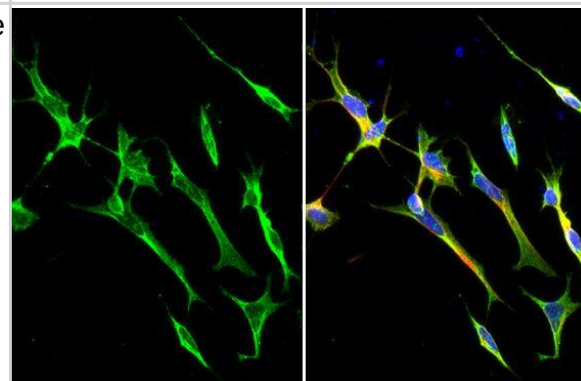
Western Blot: SARM1 Antibody (HL1070) [NBP3-13710] - Whole cell extract (30 ug) was separated by 7.5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with SARM1 antibody [HL1070] (NBP3-13710) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (NBP2-19301) was used to detect the primary antibody.



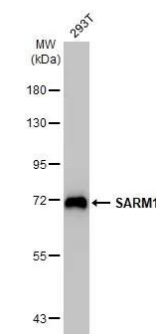
Western Blot: SARM1 Antibody (HL1070) [NBP3-13710] - Various tissue extracts (50 ug) were separated by 7.5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with SARM1 antibody [HL1070] (NBP3-13710) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody (NBP2-19301) was used to detect the primary antibody.



ICC/IF: SARM1 Antibody (HL1070) [NBP3-13710] - SH-SY-5Y cells were fixed in 4% paraformaldehyde at RT for 15 min. Green: SARM1 stained by SARM1 antibody [HL1070] diluted at 1:500. Red: alpha Tubulin, a cytoskeleton marker, stained by alpha Tubulin antibody [114] diluted at 1:1000. Blue: Fluoroshield with DAPI.
