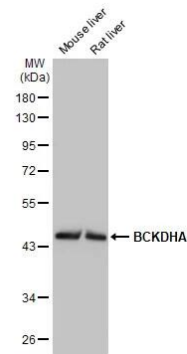

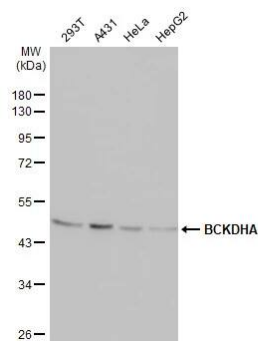

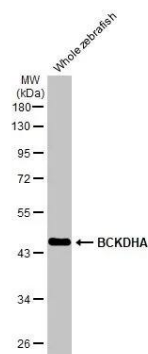

The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody.



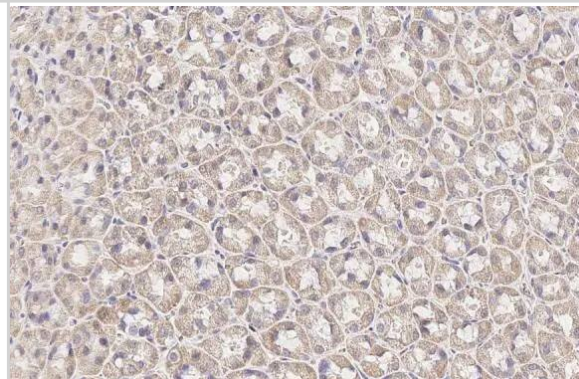
Western Blot: BCKDHA Antibody (HL2434) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP3-25382] - Various whole cell extracts (30 ug) were separated by 10% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with BCKDHA antibody [HL2434] (NBP3-25382) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody.
