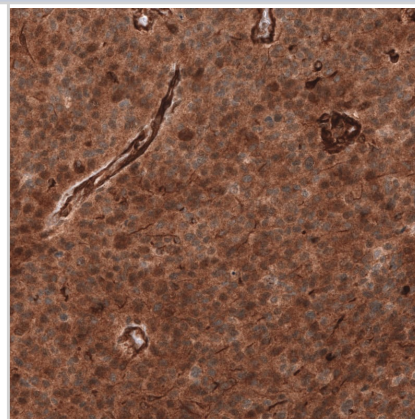

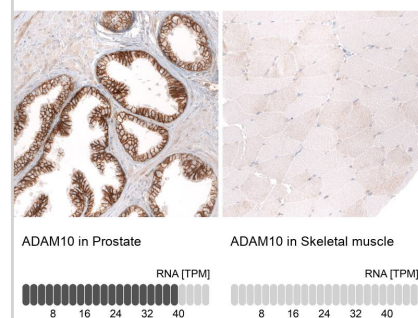

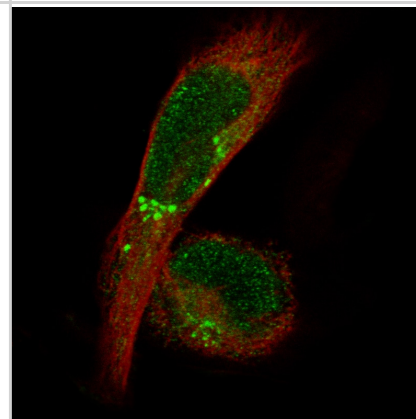
Staining of human anaplastic oligodendroglioma shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in tumor cells.



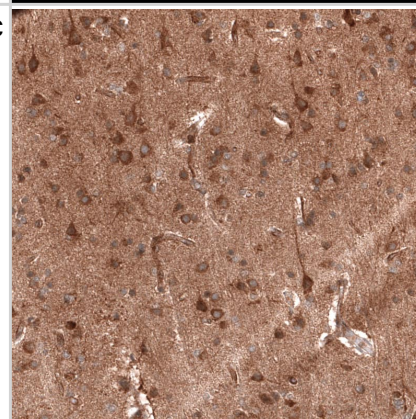

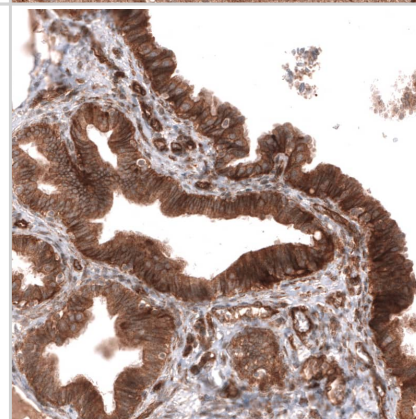
Staining in RH-30 cell line with Anti-ADAM10 monoclonal antibody) .



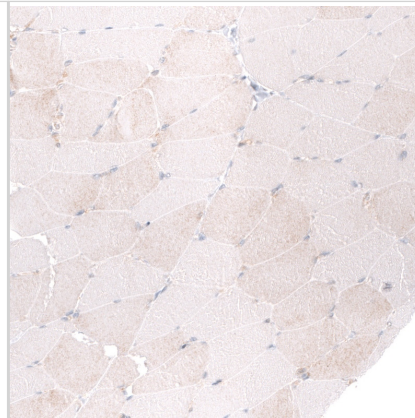
Staining of human cerebral cortex shows moderate to strong cytoplasmic positivity in neurons.



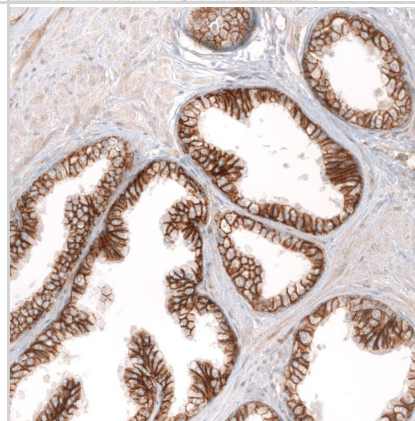
Staining of human fallopian tube shows strong membranous and cytoplasmic positivity in glandular cells.
