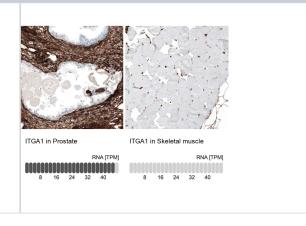

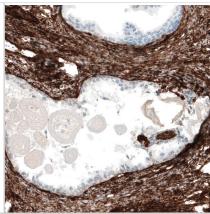

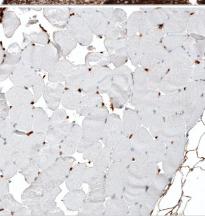




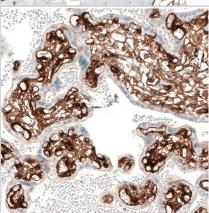
Staining of human prostate shows strong membranous positivity in smooth muscle cells.



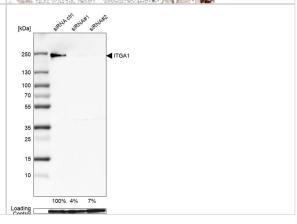
Staining of human skeletal muscle shows no positivity in striated muscle fibers as expected.



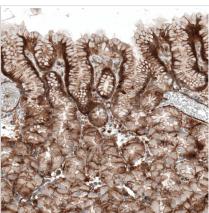
Staining of human placenta shows strong membranous positivity in blood vessels and loose connective tissue of chorionic villi.
