



Staining of A-431 cells using the Anti-Ezrin monoclonal antibody).








Lane 1: Marker [kDa]


Lane 2: Human cell line U-251 MG




Staining of human placenta shows strong membranous positivity in trophoblastic cells.




Staining of human skeletal muscle shows negative to very weak positivity in myocytes.




Staining of human rectum shows strong membranous positivity in glandular cells.
